Maulana Jalaluddin Rumi, and more popularly simply known as Rumi was a 13<sup>th</sup> century Persian poet. He was born on the Eastern shores of the Persian Empire on September 30, 1207, in the city of Balkh in what is now Afghanistan and finally settled in the town of Konya, in what is now Turkey.

# Jalaluddin Rumi



1207 – 73

A refugee himself as a child, Rumi's spirituality is suffused by a sense of cosmic homelessness and separation from God.

Founded the Sufi order commonly known in the West as the "whirling dervishes"
