



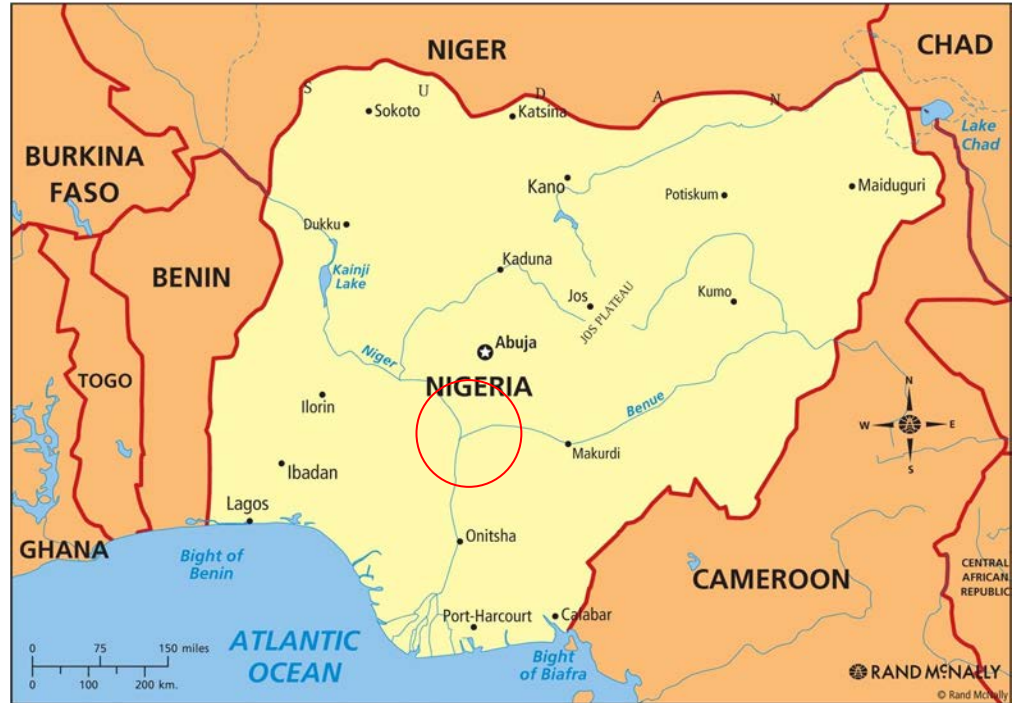

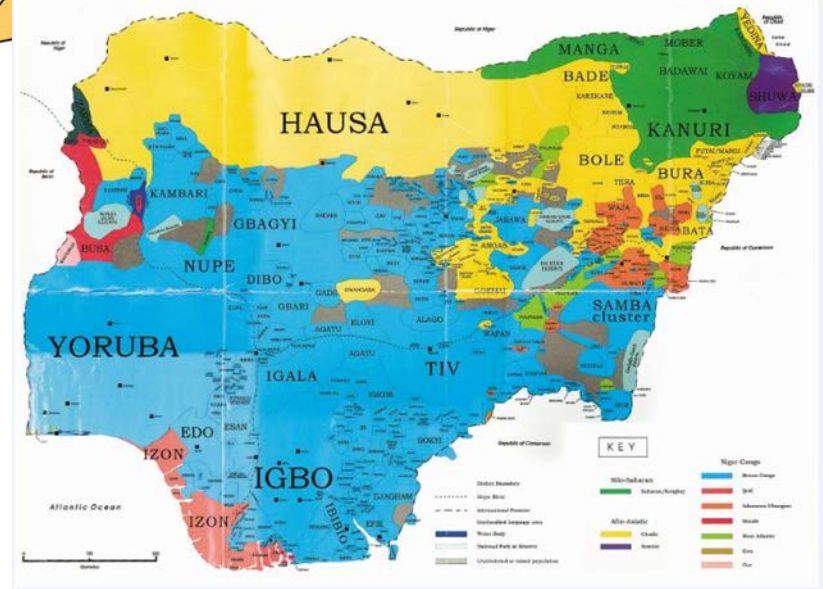
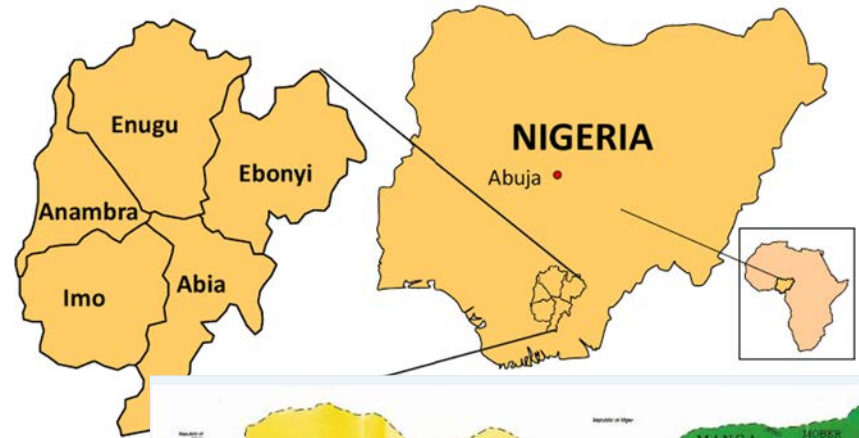
Origin

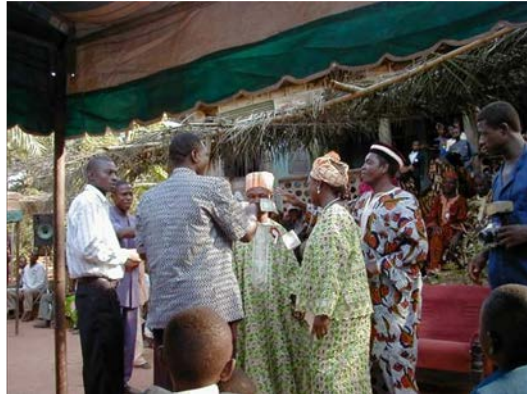

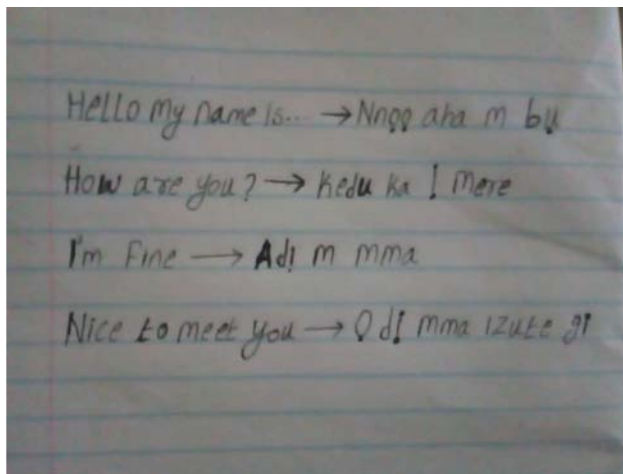

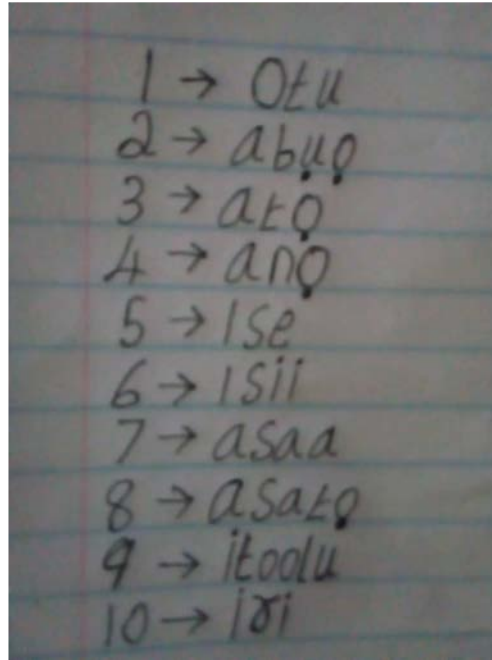
